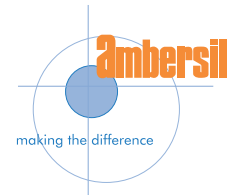


Spatter Release

SPATTER RELEASE is the traditional anti-spatter formulation, which has been developed specifically to exclude the use of any silicones or flammable solvents.

Prevents spatter adhesion on welding equipment, workpieces, surfaces, jigs and surrounding areas. Apply a light, even film from 9" - 12" (25 - 30 cm). Do not overapply.

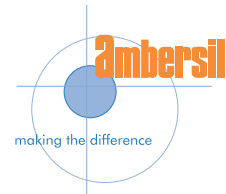
After welding, the film can be wiped away very easily and leaves no residues. Post-welding applications (e.g. painting) can then be carried out without interference.
